Credit earned from CLEP exams will appear on your transcript only after completing 12 credit hours of study at Southwestern. CLEP exams are administered at the above noted Weatherford and Sayre locations. Please call for an appointment. For best results, schedule only one CLEP per day. The cost for each CLEP exam is \$87 (subject to change). Please make an advance payment of \$15 at Southwestern's Business Office. You must present your receipt along with your driver's license to the Assessment staff for your testing appointment. Please be prepared to pay the remaining \$72 by credit card (or check if necessary) before you begin the exam. The CLEP exams for which Southwestern issues credit, the minimum scores required, and the courses for which credit can be earned are located at the bottom of this page and on the reverse side.
