



Business Development Series: *Average Business / County*

What Is It?

The average number of businesses per county shows an average number of businesses competing in a given industry for counties of similar population size in Oklahoma.

How Are They Interpreted?

These benchmark figures can be used as a tool to identify opportunities or need for additional businesses in a given industry by comparing the total number of businesses from a specific county to the average number of businesses for counties of similar size. For example, on average, there are 23 Gasoline Stations (NAICS 4471) business in counties with population range between 25,001 – 50,000 people. If Custer County with a population of 25,230 people had only 21 gasoline stations, then there may be an opportunity for additional gasoline stations in the county. However, even if an opportunity exists, it is important to bear in mind that there are other factors to take into consideration when starting a new business, which include location, cost of living, customer base, income, etc.

How Are the Numbers Calculated?

The average businesses per county are derived by, first, sorting counties of similar sizes and summing the total number of businesses competing in each 4-digit NAICS codes for these counties. And next, simply divide the sorted sum by the number of counties within each population grouping.

What Time Period?

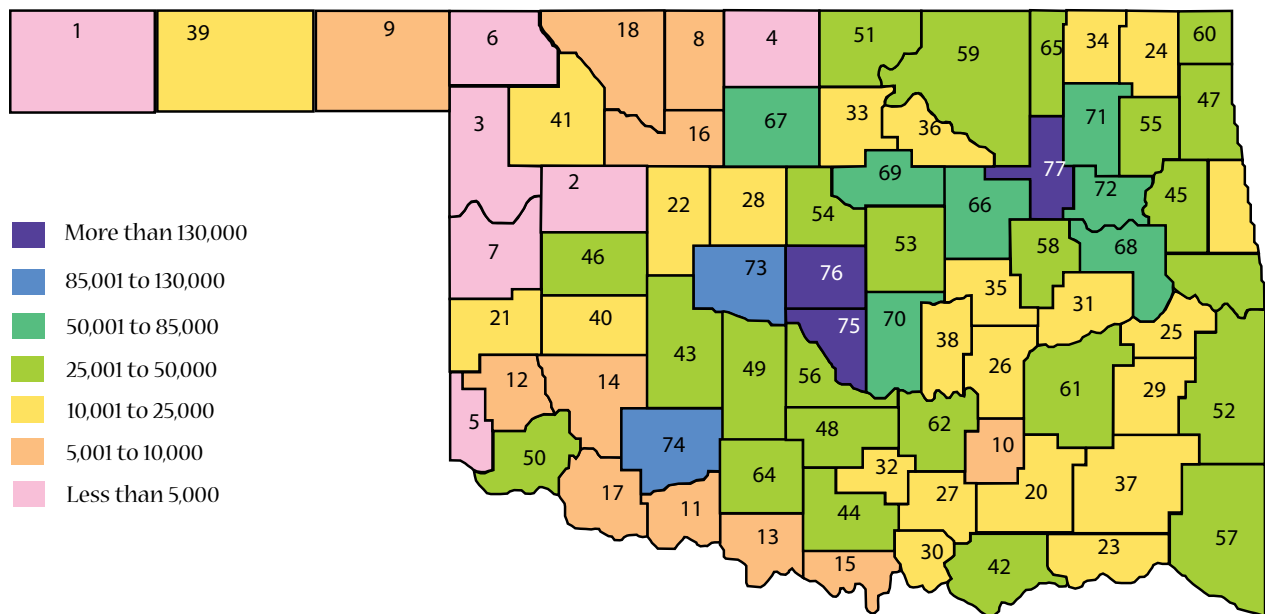
This report used 2004 population estimates from the US Census Bureau and 2005 business count data from the Oklahoma Employment Security Commission.

Who Benefits from Them?

Local entrepreneurs, chambers of commerce, economic developers, and bankers can benefit from using these figures to identify opportunities in a given region. By comparing the total number of businesses to the average number of businesses for counties of similar population size, business professionals can identify potential opportunities or threats in their local economy. For example, bankers can use these figures as guidance for loan decisions, while economic developers can use it as a tool to expand new businesses.

What are the Geographic Areas?

The average numbers of businesses per county reported in this newsletter have been calculated for seven county groupings, which are shown as follows:

Information about the Data

Analysis of the data shows that more counties were represented in the smaller population size groups, where 47 of the 77 counties or 61 percent of Oklahoma counties ranged from 10,000 to 50,000 in population. This is mainly attributed to the fact that the majority of Oklahoma's counties constitute more rural areas that are more sparsely populated. Obviously, the counties in the larger population groups were located mainly in and around Oklahoma's two major metropolitan areas, Oklahoma City and Tulsa, and other larger population centers such as Lawton, Stillwater and Enid.

Despite the various population groups, the data surprisingly showed that each population group shared high average number of businesses per county in the same type of businesses, including Agencies, Brokerages & Other Related Activities, Automotive Repair & Maintenance, Depository Credit Intermediation, Full Service Restaurants, Legal Services, Office of Physicians, etc. This indicates the similar market demands across the state. Across the different population groups, Psychiatric & Substance Abuse Hospitals displayed low average numbers of businesses per county, which may suggest an opportunity for more related businesses across the state.

The majority of counties with smaller populations have fewer businesses that are specialized, such as Cable and other Program Distribution, Data processing, Hosting & Related Services, Department Stores and Insurance Carriers, and Lessors of Non-financial Intangible Assets. This can be attributed to the fact that demand constraints in smaller population groups usually require substantial initial investments to support these types of businesses. Likewise, these types of businesses are generally utilized by larger companies that are by and large based in larger metropolitan areas.

Table 2 reports the total number of businesses in each population group for each type of business. The data used in this report was obtained from the U.S. Census Bureau and Oklahoma Employment Security Commission, and was presented in formats similar to that of Iowa State University Extension's Retail Trade Analysis Report of the Average Number of Business Per Town 2000 - 2001 (Stone & Artz, "Average Number of Business Per Town 2000 - 2001", Iowa State University Extension, Summer, 2001.)
