## SWOSU College of Pharmacy Immunization Policies for IPPE Experiential Rotations

I, the undersigned, have reviewed, clearly understand, and agree to abide by the following SWOSU College of Pharmacy Immunization Policies:

All records must be kept on file at SWOSU Student Health Services.

Students scheduled for an IPPE rotation during the summer months must provide documentation by **April 1**<sup>st</sup> **of current year** of a current TB skin test good thru **September 1**.

Check your Tetanus/Acellular Pertussis/Diphtheria (Tdap) status prior to a scheduled IPPE rotation. If that will expire before **September 1**<sup>st</sup> **of current year**, Tdap must be updated by **April 1, 2015**. (Should be renewed every 10 years).

If you are past due on the annual TB skin test by even one day, you **MUST** have **TWO** TB skin tests placed and read according to the above guidelines.

If you submit a **survey** or **TB blood test (IGRA)** in place of the TB skin test, you must fill out and submit the questionnaire or lab results according to the above guidelines for dates.

All IPPE students are required to be immunized against influenza annually.

Any student who fails to meet the immunization deadlines set by the Office of Experiential Education (OEE) will be required to drop/withdraw from the scheduled IPPE rotation until the next summer.

The rescheduling of an IPPE rotation until the following summer may result in a delay of planned graduation times because IPPE rotations cannot be scheduled during the summer just prior to the initiation of APPE rotations in the subsequent fall semester.

## **IPPE College of Pharmacy Immunization Requirements**

Before going on any experiential rotation, the following immunizations are required:

- 1. Two doses of Measles, Mumps, Rubella vaccine (MMR); will accept a valid titer
- 2. Tetanus-Acellular Pertussis-Diphtheria (Tdap) every 10 years after completion of the childhood series
- 3. Hepatitis B vaccination series of three injections; will accept a valid titer
- 4. Varicella vaccination (Chickenpox) series of two injections; will accept valid titer
- 5. Current TB skin test. **IF it has been over one year since the last test, two TB skin tests are required.** For anyone with a history of a positive TB skin test, Student Health Services needs a copy of the positive test results, chest x-ray results, and history of treatment, if any was required. You must fill out the annual questionnaire in place of a TB skin test. A negative tuberculosis blood test (IGRA) will also be accepted for documentation of negative TB status.
- 6. Annual Influenza Vaccination.

All records must be kept on file at Student Health Services.

All students scheduled for an IPPE rotation must have documentation of a current TB skin test on record with the nurse by **April 1**st **of current year** that is valid thru **September 1**st.

Check your Tdap dates at this time also. IF your Tdap will expire before or during rotations, you must update it also. The due dates correspond to the due dates listed for TB skin tests.

<u>NO EXCEPTIONS</u>: Students who do not meet the immunization deadlines and who are scheduled for IPPE rotations will be required to delay until the next summer. This MAY result in a delay of graduation.

If you are past due for your annual TB skin test by even one day, you must have two TB skin tests placed and read according to the above guidelines.

IF you submit a **survey or TB lab test (IGRA)** in place of a TB skin test, you must fill out and submit the questionnaire or lab results according to the above guidelines regarding dates.

When you have completed all of the above, please get a current cumulative copy of your summary immunization record from Student Health Services and upload it to E\*Value.
