Failing performance:

1. Failure to meet the guidelines below.
2. Failure to follow the rules of Netiquette. (Posted on Canvas)
3. Violation of any State Board of Pharmacy Law
4. HIPAA violation
5. Preceptor Grading/Evaluation (less than 2 on any item)

On-line Discussion Board

Week 1 and 3

Guidelines:

1. You must post your on-line response to the assigned discussion topic by the 3rd day of your rotation.
2. Your response to the question must have a minimum of 100 words.
Your response should be:
 - a. on topic
 - b. promote discussion from other students.
3. You must respond to a **minimum** of 2 other student postings within the week.
You must post on a minimum of **three** different days of the week. (Response to the topic and responses to a minimum of 2 other students) (For example: original post on Tuesday, Response 1 on Thursday, Response 2 on Friday.)
4. Postings to other students need to be substantial in length and can ask/answer questions or elaborate on a previous posting, but must further or expand the discussion
5. Postings such as “I agree”, “good point” will not be counted as a post.
6. Remember to follow HIPAA guidelines and respect the privacy of others.
7. Students should be familiar with the grading rubric to ensure maximum points. (see reverse side)
8. Professional language, spelling, and grammar are required.

Grading: A faculty moderator will grade or evaluate the discussion board topics. Students who do not earn 75% of the available points will fail their IPPE course.

On-line Calculations Quiz

Week 2

- 12 random questions
- Minimum score of 75% - Maximum of 2 attempts
- Must download the Respondus LockDown Browser
- Quiz must be completed on or before the deadline posted in Canvas and emailed to you.
- Failure to complete the Calculations Quiz on or before the deadline with a 75% or better score will result in a failure of the IPPE course

Pharmacist Letter Quizzes

Week 2

- Minimum score of 90% is required.
