- Disengagement if unable to fit in
- Roommate conflicts
- Long distance relationship strain
- Unsure how to organize and self-motivate to develop consistent study habits



OCTOBER

- Exploration of personal values and group identity
- Behind in class work/need to engage with instructors, tutoring and study groups
- Roommate conflicts emerge
- Need to reconcile social and academic lives
- Masks start to come off
- Conflicts and confusion result when confronting, often for the first time, different perspectives including bias and heterosexual/homosexual/bisexual standards
- Fear of failure due to midterms and tests
