Early Decision Admission Opportunity

Students with outstanding academic achievement are invited to apply for Early Decision admission to our Radiologic Technology program, which offers priority consideration for up to 60% of available program seats. This pathway is designed for applicants who have demonstrated strong preparation and meet the following criteria:

- 1. Cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher
- 2. Completion of all prerequisite and general education courses
- 3. Grade of A in Anatomy
- 4. Over 45 total college hours

See the tiered structure below for application deadlines. Admission decisions for Early Decision applicants will be released on or before **April 15**. Those admitted through the Early Decision process can secure their place in the program before the regular admission cycle. Applicants who are not offered early admission will automatically have their applications reconsidered during the standard review period and will remain eligible for admission through the regular process. The regular admission deadline is **May 15**.

Tiered Early Decision Structure

Within the Early Decision Admission Opportunity, applicants will be reviewed in the following tiers:

Level 1 Early Admission:

- Applicants who meet all early admission opportunity requirements with a cumulative GPA
 of at least 3.75 and a minimum of 60 completed college credit hours are eligible to apply as
 Level 1 Early Admission candidates.
- Level 1 Early Admission applications must be completed and submitted by March 1 for priority review within the Early Decision pool.
- Qualified Level 1 applicants will be reviewed first and may receive early offers of admission, contingent upon continued academic performance and completion of all prerequisite and program requirements.

Level 2 Early Admission:

- Applicants who meet all early admission opportunity requirements with a cumulative GPA
 of at least 3.50 and a minimum of 45 completed college credit hours are eligible to apply as
 Level 2 Early Admission candidates.
- Level 2 Early Admission applications must be completed and submitted by April 1 for priority review after Level 1 applicants and before the regular admission pool.
- Qualified Level 2 applicants may receive early offers of admission, contingent upon continued academic performance and completion of all prerequisite and program requirements.

• Regular Admission:

 Applicants who do not meet Level 1 or Level 2 criteria, or who apply after the early admission deadlines but on or before **May 15**, will be considered in the regular admission pool according to the standard program admission criteria and timelines.
