

Weatherford Community Scholarship

Resident and Non-Resident Transfer Students

This scholarship application is for any transfer student, *Oklahoma resident or non-resident*, who has *earned at least 36 credit hours* at other higher education institutions. Transfer students completing this application and filing official up-to-date college transcripts with the SWOSU Registrar's Office by January 15th for spring or June 15th for fall will be considered for the Weatherford Community Scholarship.

Weatherford Community Scholarships

These scholarships are available to both *Oklahoma residents and non-residents* who are enrolling at SWOSU for the first time. This award may be applied toward tuition, fees, room, board at SWOSU. The award will be \$1,500 for one year (\$750 per semester). Priority will be given to those applicants already having associate degrees.
