<p>Passing the National League of Nurse's NACE Challenge Exams with a 70% or higher on both exams.</p>	<p>Passing the NACE is required for ALL students submitting a nursing application. Obtaining at least 70% on both exams is required for full admission.</p> <p>NACE scores need to be received by the close of the application cycle <b>(May 1st or October 1st)</b>.</p>
<p>Passing the National League of Nurse's NACE Challenge Exams with scores of 60-69% on both exams.</p>	<p>Students potentially may be admitted on conditional standing. <b>Obtaining these scores does not guarantee admission into the program.</b> Higher scores will be favored over lower scores. Students admitted on conditional standing will be required to pass the NACE Remediation Exam with 90%. The NACE Remediation Exam is only available for students admitted on conditional standing. <b>NACE scores need to be received by the close of the application cycle (May 1st or October 1st).</b></p>
<p>Passing the National League of Nurse's NACE Challenge Exams with scores of 59% or less on one or both exams.</p>	<p>Students who obtain scores less than 60% on one or both NACE exams will likely not be admitted to the program. Students may opt to retake the NACE exams and may do so every 30 days. <b>NACE scores need to be received by the close of the application cycle (May 1st or October 1st).</b> There is no limit to the number of tests taken in a year.</p>

	Students may also opt to reapply during the next application cycle after focusing on improving scores.
