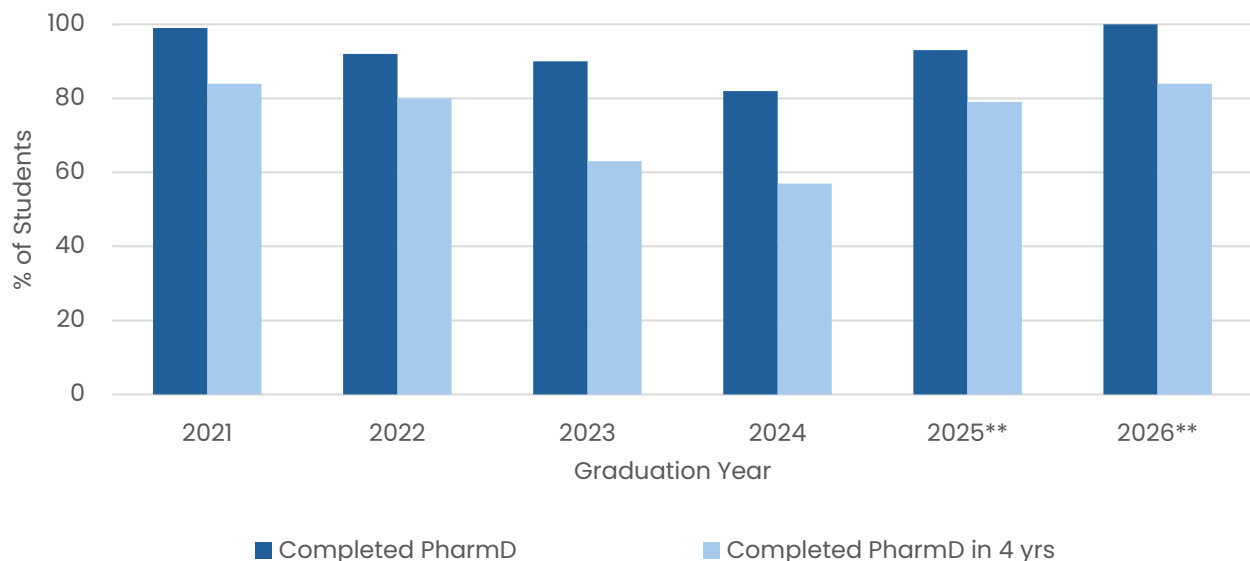

Graduation Rates



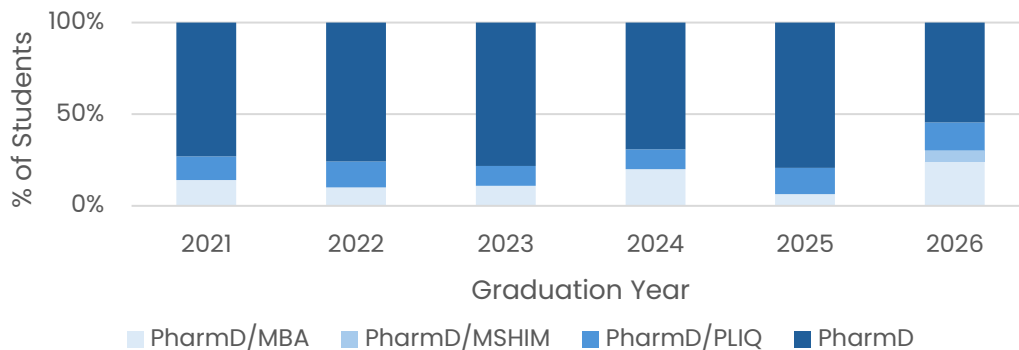
