The Immunization Training Program is 6 hours total, online work (2 hours) and live attendance (4 hours). The enrollment link will be sent to you for the 2 hours of home-study material after your registration and payment has been confirmed. **The on-line homework is to be completed prior to the on-site 4-hour class program.**

CPR is NOT PART of the Immunization Training Program

You are responsible for completing CPR training prior to the classroom program or attending the CPR session offered prior to immunization training on Saturday, Sept 19, 2026, from 8:00-12:00 PM (separate enrollment form attached).

Class size is limited to 18 technicians. PLEASE REGISTER EARLY.

Home Learning Objectives:

At the completion of the home-study component, the learner will be able to:

- Describe proper technique when drawing up and administering immunizations
- Recognize commonly used vaccines and their corresponding routes of administration
- Distinguish proper needle length selection based on vaccine and patient age and size
- Identify proper documentation procedures
- Recall vaccine storage requirements
- Describe safety measures to avoid accidental needle stick injuries
- Recognize appropriate actions to take in emergency situations

Live Seminar Learning Objectives:

Demonstrate a successful technique when administering an intramuscular and subcutaneous injection.

Demonstrate appropriate distraction techniques during immunization administration.

Demonstrate the use of universal precautions as they pertain to bloodborne pathogens

Explain the procedures for managing a vaccine reaction emergency

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS AND CONTINUING EDUCATION CREDIT

Program requirements include:

- 1) completing the 2-hour home-study material prior to attending the on-site classroom program and completing the final, an open book quiz online with 70% or better,
- 2) participating in the entire 4-hour classroom program and
- 3) proof of your current CPR card to SWOSU College of Pharmacy Rural Health at the time of the live session.

CPR NOTE: Although not included in Southwestern's IMMUNIZATION TRAINING PROGRAM, as part of the Program Requirements, you must provide proof of completing CPR training. You are responsible for completing CPR training prior to the classroom program.

To validate your APhA certificate and meet national pharmacy standards, your basic CPR training must be accredited by an accepted credentialing body:

- **Basic Cardiac Life Support (BCLS)** or Basic Life Support (BLS) for Healthcare Providers.
- Programs accredited by the **American Heart Association (AHA)**, **American Red Cross**, or an ACPE-approved provider.

REGISTRATION AND FEES - SPACE IS LIMITED, SO REGISTER EARLY!

The registration fee is \$259 per person and must be paid by September 12, 2026. No registrations will be accepted after September 12, 2026. Class size is limited to 18 technicians.
